#### **TOUR ITINERARY:**

Day 1: Timisoara - Baile Herculane, Romania Arrival at airport in Timisoara, Romania. You will be welcomed by the Romanian guide who will accompany you throughout the entire tour. If there is enough time, you will have a short sightseeing tour through Timisoara, the capital of the Banat region which is often referred to as the "Vienna of the Balkans". You will then drive through the Southern Carpathians to Baile Herculane, approx. 190 km (2,5 h). Overnight/ dinner Hotel Afrodita\*\*\*.

## Day 2: Baile Herculane, Romania

Baile Herculane is located in south-western Romania in the valley of the Cerna river (390 km north-west of Bucharest), one of the oldest and main spas in Romania. Its 16 thermal springs have different mineral characteristics and temperatures between 38° C and 67° C. The Thermal Spa &

Wellness Centre, located in the Hotel Afrodita, allows a complete escape from the stress of modern life. Today you will explore the resort by visiting the nearby Outlaws Cave. The cave, inhabited since the Age of Fire and also known in Roman times, became a refuge and hiding place for thieves during the modern era. Here, objects and primitive tools of the Paleolithical Era, Roman vases and coins, as well as various treasures were discovered. During the rest of the day, you can enjoy the Spa & Wellness Centre which is ideal for relaxation and anti-aging treatments with thermal water and its beneficial effect on the skin. It is also recommended by dermatologists for many skin conditions. Today you also take a tour to the Steam Grotto, a Natural Sauna in Baile Herculane, a narrow cave with darkgreen walls, filled with vapors of hot spring water which springs through the cracks of the rocky wall. Overnight/dinner Hotel Afrodita\*\*\*.

#### Day 3: Baile Herculane, Romania

After breakfast, you will leave to **Orsova** (approx. 21 km) for the **Danube river cruise** through the **Iron Gate National Park**, formerly the Danube Gorge, which was considered a death trap for boatmen. Although the once dangerous cliffs have been flooded by the reservoir, the landscape has lost nothing of its impressive shape. Explore the amazing landscape during the cruise. In the afternoon, visit the **Roman Catholic church of Orsova**, built in a quite unusual and non-conformist style with its interior painted in water colours by the artist Gabriel Popa. If you prefer to **relax**, you access the **thermal baths** in Baile Herculane and recover from an exciting day. Overnight/dinner **Hotel Afrodita\*\*\***.



Day 4: Baile Herculane - Turnu Severin -Calafat, Romania - Vidin, Bulgaria - Sofia Today you will visit the Archeological Museum in Turnu Severin. The museum exhibits pieces from natural sciences, historical documents, archaeology (including a lapidary from Roman times), remains from the Dacian civilization, ancient Roman monuments, numismatics and ethnography (costumes, pottery, and woven area), Romanian fine arts and an important piece of the ancient bridge from Drobeta Turnu Severin, built by the architect Apolodorus of Damascus during the Dacian-Roman war (103-105 AD). On your journey to the Bulgarian capital Sofia, you will have lunch break (if there is time) in Varshets, a city near a mineral spring that, in the sixth century AD, used to be the only place described with Medeka (healing) in the entire Roman empire. On the way to Bulgaria, you say goodbye to the Romanian guide and cross the new Danube bridge from Calafat to Vidin where

you will be welcomed by your Bulgarian guide. After finishing all border formalities, you continue the journey to Sofia. Overnight/dinner Hotel Arena di Serdica\*\*\*\*\*.

#### Day 5: Sofia - Hisarya, Bulgaria

In the morning, you will explore the **Bulgarian capital Sofia**. The first stop is the Amphitheatre of Serdica and the **Church of St. George**; the oldest building in Sofia built by the Romans in the 4th century. Furthermore, you visit the **Banya Bashi Mosque (literally "many baths")** – named after the neighbouring Central Baths and built on top of natural thermal spas. After the city tour there is time for **shopping** and a short lunch break. Then you will depart to Hisarya (approx. 165 km). Overnight/dinner **Hotel Hissar\*\*\*\***.

### Day 6: Hisarya

Today you take a **city tour of Hisarya**, a historical town in central Bulgaria (45 km north of

Plovdiv and 165 km south-east of Sofia) and a modern, world famous balneotherapy resort, one of the biggest in Bulgaria. Here, one can find 22 mineral springs with a temperature between 37°C and 52°C. During the tour, you will visit the Roman heritage of the city, such as the South Gate of the Roman town Diocletianopolis, the ancient Amphitheatre, the Colonades and the Fortress wall. In the afternoon, you will have some free time to relax in the thermal pools or book an exclusive "Diocletian Package" in the Spa centre in the Hissar Spa Hotel, equipped with state-of-the-art modules for relaxation & recreation, restoring vitality and care for body and mind. The 42°C warm mineral water from "Parilkite" spring is one of the best-quality sources with a proven healing effect of pure natural water. The hyper thermal water is slightly mineralized, hydro-carbonated with sulfate, chloride, fluorine sulfate and alkaline, which can be used for drinking cures and is suitable for hydrotherapy treatments. Overnight/dinner Hotel Hissar\*\*\*\*.

#### Day 7: Hissar - Plovdiv - Hisarya

You will leave for a **daytrip to Plovdiv**, Bulgaria's second biggest and one of the world's oldest cities. Discover its beautiful surrounding nature. Plovdiv has been chosen **European Capital of Culture 2019**. Here you will make a tour of the famous Old Town, a candidate for a UNESCO World Heritage site. Visit the best preserved **Roman Theatre** (2nd century) in Bulgaria, which is still used for live performances and admire the newly reopened Ancient Stadium (2nd century), that can accommodate 30.000 spectators. The Ethnographic Museum is also a point of interest due

to its exhibition of costumes and instruments. Enjoy a trip to the **Rose Valley** which made Bulgaria famous for production of the **best rose oil in the** world. After returning to your hotel, you can book one of the **Health & Wellness Package in the Spa**. Overnight/dinner **Spa Hotel Hissar\*\*\*\***.

#### Day 8: Hisarya - Sofia

After breakfast, **transfer to the airport in Sofia**, to take your flight back home.


